



ECT Sponsors Munich Chamber Orchestra's Modern Night Music Concert Series

Once again ECT engages in the concert series in the Pinakothek der Moderne museum, jointly with BMW

Munich December 10, 2013: ECT (European Computer Telecoms AG), vendor of complete solutions for value-added services in the voice and multimedia domain, sponsors the Munich Chamber Orchestra's (MKO) concert series Modern Night Music (Nachtmusik der Moderne). The Modern Night Music series consist of three concerts, which are staged in the contemporary arts museum Pinakothek der Morderne in Munich. Each concert is dedicated to another contemporary composer.

At the first concert, on December 14th 2013, the MKO will play pieces by the American composer Charles Ives (1874-1954) with the solo artists Burghard Mehring on the piano and with soprano singer Christiane Iven.

Concert number two is scheduled for March 22nd 2014 and is dedicated to the Austrian composer Friedrich Cerha (born 1926). Trombone player Uwe Schrodi will be the evening's solo artist.

The third concert will be on May 31st 2014. Thomas Larcher (born 1963), also from Austria, will be the evening's composer. The solo artists are Nils Mönkemeyer on the viola and Igor Levit on the piano.
