You serve as the voice of these two user groups to guide development teams in building software capabilities with the highest business and customer impact. You recognize business needs, prioritize and manage the T-LCAP backlog, and incorporate feedback from internal and external stakeholders to guide continuous improvement. You develop roadmaps with continuous value increments, expanding our low-code and no-code capabilities as required for the composition of telecoms products and services.

Responsibilities

- Guide all stages of software development, including user story development, sprint planning, and prioritization of the product backlog.
- Understand business and end-user needs; identify and prioritize features to be delivered to meet those needs.
- Work with business and technical stakeholders to develop and document user stories.
- Participate in sprint planning to determine the team's objectives for the upcoming sprint.

- Assist the squads on the development of feature tests, test cases, and regression tests.
